

ATTENTION: Change in method for accessing UBC Library e-resources: CWL sign-in required

License agreements with publishers dictate that changes will soon occur in the method you use to access UBC Library resources.

UBC students, staff and faculty will continue to have access to all library resources, however Campus Wide Login (CWL) sign-in will soon be required from TRIUMF computers.
